

## NRL VICTORIA ADVISORY PANEL OVERVIEW

## Overview

The NRL Victoria Advisory Panel operates under the framework of the Terms of Reference for the ARLC VIC Football Committee voted on by the Directors of ARLC VIC Limited (located on NRL Victoria's website).

The Advisory Panel reports to the NRL Victoria General Manager and is designed to support the sustainability and growth of NRL competitions and programs within Victoria, in alignment with the NRL's strategic direction in an advisory capacity.

The Advisory Panel should be engaged on a strategic level to provide guidance and support to the organisation while also assessing the likely success of operational initiatives through constructive feedback.

NRL Victoria management is responsible for preparing the communication, policies and associated operational responsibilities for the Advisory Panel.

Whilst the Advisory Panel plays a critical role in the development of Rugby League in Victoria, all final decisions regarding the strategic direction and operations will rest with the NRL Victoria management. The Advisory Panel does not have any executive powers with regards to its findings or recommendations.

## Roles

The Advisory Panel is a volunteer panel managed by NRL Victoria General Manager but other employees of the NRL may partake in these meetings from time to time.

Permanent roles on the Advisory Panel shall consist of the following portfolios:

- Referees one (1) representative
- Senior competitions / clubs minimum one (1) and maximum two (2) representatives
- Junior competitions / clubs minimum one (1) and maximum two (2) representatives
- Female competitions / programs one (1) representative
- NRL VIC representative / high performance programs one (1) representative

Other roles and portfolios may be added from time to time on a needs basis.

Positions will be reviewed on an annual basis.

## **Meeting Schedules**

The Advisory Panel will meet as frequently as required but is likely to be 4 times per year.
