

NRL VICTORIA

2024 REGISTRATION POLICY



Along with the [NRL Terms and Conditions of Registration](#), NRL VIC specifically reserves the right to decline to register any registrant (Player, Official or Volunteer) or deregister any existing registration where any one or more of the following circumstances apply:

- a) registrant has failed to complete all compulsory fields or provide required identification upon registration on MySideline;
- b) registrant has provided identification which is invalid or does not meet [NRL Registration Policy](#) requirements
- c) registrant has registered with a name or date of birth which does not match their provided identification (noting registrant can still provide a “preferred name” upon registration)
- d) registrant has been suspended from playing in a competition under the administration of the NRL VIC for a period of not less than twelve (12) months;
- e) registrant is currently serving a suspension or has been refused registration from within rugby league or a recognised governing body of any other sport;
- f) as a player has been suspended from playing in a competition for a period of more than eight (8) weeks on more than two (2) occasions in any three (3) consecutive Football Years;
- g) as a player, the player’s Parent, Primary Care Provider or other family members are sanctioned for breaching the NRL Code of Conduct;
- h) registrant has struck a Referee or any other Official either on or off the field of play;
- i) as a player has been convicted of an Anti-Doping Rule Violation under the [NRL Anti-Doping Policy](#);
- j) registrant has been convicted of a criminal offence punishable at law to a period of imprisonment of more than twelve (12) months.
- k) registrant has been charged with a criminal offence can be refused registration until the outcome of his/her charges has been finalised.
- l) the registrant has committed a material breach of the NRL VIC Rules, Policies and/or NRL and/or NRL VIC Code of Conduct.
- m) as a player, the player has not completed the necessary process for initiating a clearance or release from a previous Club, including international clearance requirements;
- n) the registrant, at the sole discretion of the NRL VIC, is deemed to not adhere to the beliefs of the NRL or NRL VIC

Upon a registration being declined or deregistered, the registrant’s club shall receive notification in the first instance.

Any decision to refuse any registration pursuant to the provisions of this Policy can then be appealed directly to the NRL VIC General Manager within 72 hours of notice by either the club on the registrant’s behalf, or the registrant themselves.
